THE IMWA FOLLOWS THE IWF JURY RULES



HERE ARE THE BASICS:

➤ Be on time at your assigned seat and ready for the TECHNICAL OFFICIALS PRESENTATION



- > Be impartial and assertive to all lifters regardless which nation, including your own.
 - * We are no police force.
 - * The Jury must wait to judge until the barbell has touched the ground again.
 - * Use common sense rather than chasing mistakes or to be too relaxed in any decision.
 - * Wear the correct uniform to be identified in your position.
 - * No phone or tablet use while on duty.
 - * All Jury members must be IWF/IMWA category I Technical Officials



AT ALL IMWA WORLDS AND CONTINENTAL MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS THERE IS A 3 BENCH JURY EACH JURY MEMBER MUST BE CATEGORY 1 TECHNICAL OFFICIAL



The Jury has the ultimate control on the Field of Play and its primary function is to ensure that the Technical competition rules are being correctly followed and applied.



The Jury is not a Jury of appeal.

There is no appeal against the Jury's decision!!

EACH JURY MEMBER MUST:

- be friendly and courteous
- be wearing the correct uniform
- be aware of, and sensitive to, language, cultural and religious differences
- promote a safe and harassment free environment where participants are treated with respect
- Judgement by using the jury control unit after the barbell returned back on the platform
- be fair, firm and decisive
- Use common sense
- Be able to act as a manual scorekeeper, if required and requested by the Jury President





EACH JURY MEMBER MUST NOT:

- attempt to influence the decisions of other...Jury members or referees
- Must no use devises like tablet or phone during the competition

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE JURY PRESIDENT:




- communicate in English; Jury President must converse fluently in English assess technical difficulties offer guidance
- work cooperatively and collaboratively
- assert a degree of authority
- be objective in decision making
- ❖ be discerning and not be easily influenced nor attempt to influence
- ❖ act and react in a calm manner
- * be proactive rather than reactive
- be respectful and courteous to colleagues
- ❖ Be open to learn from extensive international experience as a Technical Official




- > The President of the Jury controls and signs all Technical Officials' Cards.
- At all IMWA Events, the Jury President shall appoint an individual to complete a manual Protocol as a back-up document.
- > The Jury President signs the protocol sheet after the end of a session.
- The President of the Jury assigns a Jury Member to keep eye contact with the Technical Controller after each lift.











IMPORTANT FOR THE SMOOTH RUNNING OF A COMPTITION

- The Jury to keep eye contact with the Technical Controller (TC) after each attempt (Decision reversal, bar cleaning, outfit issue, etc.)



- Jury may stop the competition:
- When Jury President looking at other Members, left and right, in a serious manner, Jury may stop the competition






At IMWA events a 3 (three) Bench Jury is appointed.

UNLESS UNANIMITY is reached in the first instance, the Jury cannot take any action even if the decision of the Referees appears to be totally incorrect.

If the Jury unanimously agrees that a lift should have been passed or failed and that differs from a majority of the Referee's decision, in order to consider the reversal of a decision, the President of the Jury must:









- a) Order that the competition be stopped informing both the TC and Speaker.
- b) In case the Jury President calls the Referee(s) in question for an explanation, he/she must ask the members of the Jury if they accept or reject the Referees' explanation.
- c) If the explanation is accepted by the Jury, no action is taken and the competition is ordered to restart.
- d) If the explanation is not accepted, the decision must be reversed on the screen
- e) Request the Technical Controller to communicate the decision and its reason to the Speaker requesting that such decision and its reason be announced to the public and to the athlete/coach concerned.
- n Order the restart of the competition.



Whenever the Jury decides to stop the competition, the Jury President MUST ACT IMMEDIATELY BY PRESSING THE 'TECHNICAL STOP JURY BUTTON'












IMMEDIATELY CLICK TECH STOP!!



THROUGH THE JURY SCREEN the Jury can call the TECHNICAL CONTROLLER AND EACH REFEREE SEPARATELY






When Jury reverses the decision to GOOD LIFT:

RESULT CHANGES ON THE SCORE BOARD TO GOOD LIFT





When Jury reverses the decision to NO LIFT:

SAME ATHLETE'S SECOND ATTEMPT 1 KG INCREASE



TECHNICAL JURY STOP DONE AT THE IURY TABLE



2) GOOD LIFT MAJORITY DECISION BY REFEREES



JURY REVERSES THE REFEREE'S DECISION





RESULT CHANGES ON THE SCORE BOARD TO NO LIFT





JURY Decision making process for attempts with loading errors:

If the barbell is loaded to a lighter weight than the one requested by the athlete, the athlete may, if he/she wishes, either accept the attempt if it was successful or refuse it. If he/she refuses the attempt, the athlete is granted an additional attempt with the weight originally requested.





If the barbell is loaded to a weight which is not a multiple of 1 kg and the lift is successful, the athlete may accept the attempt at the next lower weight or refuse it. If the athlete refuses the attempt, he/she is granted an additional attempt with the weight originally requested.



If the barbell is loaded to a heavier weight than the one requested by the athlete, the athlete may, if he/she wishes accept the attempt if it was successful. If the attempt is not successful or if the barbell is not a multiple of 1 kg, the athlete is automatically granted an additional attempt with the weight originally requested.







IN WHAT CASES THE JURY MUST GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LIFT TO A LIFTER?

- If a lift is failed because the barbell is not equally loaded, or the platform is damaged or the barbell becomes disarranged during the lift; or there is an incursion or any other external interference, the Jury must grant an additional attempt for the affected athlete.
- If the Speaker makes a serious error during the announcement of an athlete's name or the calling of the weight the Jury must grant another attempt.



In addition, the President of the Jury has the following specific responsibilities:

- Supervise the Referee Light System control panel and call the Referees for explanation when needed
- Monitor the decisions of both the Referees and the Jury
- Operate the Jury Control Panel
- Communicate with Technical Controllers, Timekeeper, Chief Marshal,
 Competition Management and Speaker by Technical Jury Stop
- Assign a manual scorekeeper within the Jury
- Enable TOs to remove their jacket by hot venue.
